

## (Possible) Ancestors of Peter Michael Dennison in the UKCensus

*Baildon EP was created in 1719 from Otley AP, which largely embraces Guiseley AP from the north. Rose Grove appears to be situated in Burnley, Lancashire, which, as I have noted elsewhere, is probably in Whalley Parish. Windhill EP was created from Idle EP in 1870, which was created from Calverley AP, 4.5 miles NE of Bradford. See the 1891 entry for Jessie and Dorothy's Sweet natal family, below.*

*Even though Emma is shown as having been married 4 years (spanning the time of George's birth in 1909), this seems like a strong candidate to be James William, the father of Peter's George. His occupation and birthplace are the same, and he matches reasonably close in age to the son of Arthur in 1881. He has also named a son Arthur. The strongest argument, though, is that Peter believes that his ancestor George had sibs named Arthur and Lilly Bell,*

*born about the same time as these children (he has dates closer to the putative marriage of James William to Florence Mary Sweet, about the end of 1902, but these dates may have been guesstimated.*

*It seems, therefore, that James William must indeed be a son of Arthur who deserted Arthur's family's longstanding engagement in the clothing business. However, James William is not to be found in either the 1891 or 1901 censuses (either as James or as William) yet instead I find the following households that appear to closely match this 1911 household (abstracted in full below):*

1891 William 14 iron moulder's apprentice (son of William who is an "iron moulders fireman")  
1901 William 24 iron moulder, married to Emma (26, b. Bradford), son Arnold 3  
1911 William 36 iron turner, married to Emma (34, b. Keighley)

*Since I found a separate entry for the 1901 William, with son Arnold, in the 1911 census, this alternate lineage, going back to 1891 William, can be dismissed.*

\* 1901 UKCensus \*  
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*My search for "William Den\*" in Yorkshire born 1862-1882 turned up just 2 of them born in Bradford, and one of these with middle initial "A", son of Joseph. Both of these Williams were iron moulders and so are prime candidates to match the 1891 William and the 1911 William, however the first 1901 William is married to Emma, the same wife's name as the 1911 William. I have nonetheless abstracted both of these Williams.*

*My search for "James Den\*" in Yorkshire born 1862-1882 turned up 2 born in Bradford. I've abstracted both, as well as the James W Dennison born in Kingston upon Hull. Only one of these three, though, is unmarried - the boarder, with Sarah Dennison 84, with a Harrison family, and this James worked in a woolen mill and is probably the son in 1891 of Moses, of Bradford St Andrew.*

*Since son George was born in Lancashire, I searched that county for both James and William "Den\*", but found just one James and two Williams, both born in Lancashire.*

*I have also abstracted the SWEET household in this census, as it shows the three sisters later associated with the baby George: Florence, his mother; and in the 1911 George Holmes household, his wife Jessie, and her sister, Dorothy Sweet. George (2) is listed as a nephew of the householder.*

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My search on "James Den\*" born 1873-1878 turned up 6 James DENNISONs, 3 of them born in Bradford, but one of these had the middle name Henry; I abstracted the other two, and also one of the non-Bradford James's who had middle initial W. My search on "William Den\*" born 1868-1878 turned up 4 Williams, only two of them born in Bradford; I have abstracted both. However, only one of these belongs to a family of metal industry workers, and the William of this family is an iron moulder's apprentice, and is thereby the only candidate William or James in this census born in Bradford with an occupation that matches that of the 1911 William.

Meanwhile, there were only three "Arthur Den\*" in England, two born in Yorkshire, and neither have families that match that of the 1881 Arthur & Harriet of Bradford. In fact the only Harriett DENNISON in England in this census born 1854-1858 was born in Lincolnshire, not Bradford. Of the two Arthurs born in Yorkshire, one was indeed born in Yeadon, like the 1881 Arthur, so he is presumably the same Arthur, although he is now married to Sibul and has no children matching his previous children with Harriet; I have abstracted this Arthur, below. This Arthur still has an occupation in the cloth industry, while the 1911 William is in iron.

The above James is a possible, but his occupation is wrong. The civil parish here is Allerton, and the ecclesiastical parish, St Peter's Bradford, was originally part of Horton. As for the older children's birth places, there are many Thorntons in Yorkshire West Riding, but the one meant here is evidently what was originally a chapelry in Bradford, erected into an ecclesiastical parish in 1760, and since further subdivided. Christopher and family (minus James) are still on Jesse St, in Bradford West, in 1901, though their address has changed to 38 Jesse St.

*So many Denison families, nearly all in the clothing trades, are concentrated in Enumeration Districts 4 and 5 constituting Guiseley (Yeadon Twp), that I have gone through every page of these UKCensus sections and abstracted every family for 1841. Other nearby areas too should be canvassed in order to sort out all of these families. Note that in 1845 Yeadon Twp of Guiseley was hived off to form its own ecclesiastical parish so most of these Denisons will be found in Yeadon parish in the next, 1851, UKCensus. From the occupations found in these census sections, Yeadon was evidently the woolen processing and clothing district of the burgeoning city of Bradford.*

*I find no evidence here, though, that the William & Elizabeth couple abstracted below were the parents of Peter's ancestor Robert.
